



Support:


The community managers are always available to answer questions and you will be supported by teachers in weekly online tutorials.


After successfully participating in VORsprung, you can apply to our partner universities.

What to bring?

A school certificate that entitles you to apply to a preparatory college (Studienkolleg) in Germany, as well as German language skills at least at level B1.

If you are unsure whether your certificate is suitable for VORsprung, you can do a certificate check:



You need proof of your German language skills, for example:

- TestDaF 3
- DSD I or DSD I PRO
- Goethe-Zertifikat B1
- Telc German B1
- Proof from the school if German is the language of instruction
- Language school certificates
- DSH 1 for refugees who are already in Germany

Your school report and language certificates must be submitted in German or English.

You need a laptop or PC and a stable internet connection for the course.
